As a PM Delegate, your responsibilities will be to represent the views of the PMs in your area and to vote on issues at the USDF Convention in 2011 in San Diego. The term will run from the time you are elected until the next election occurs in 2012. It will be important for delegates to know how participating members in your area feel about various issues that arise so you know how to vote. There is usually e-mail contact with other Delegate which will keep you informed about the issues that will come up at the Board of Governors' Meeting. You will need to be at the convention to attend the Committee meetings in order to be well informed, and then attend the Board of Governors meeting.
