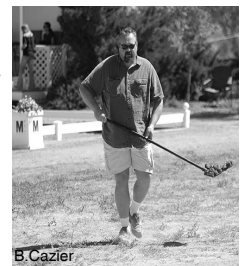

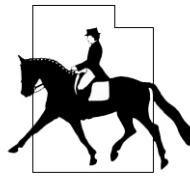
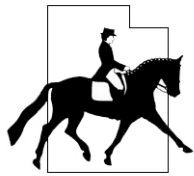

Joanie Bolton Clinic

Part Three: *A Few Simple Tips To Improve Your Connection*

This three part series takes a small glimpse into the Joanie Bolton clinics that are held monthly between Sandy and Heber. In the first article of this series we talked about several common dressage “myths”. In part two we looked at just a few biomechanics principles. Now in this final installment we will discuss a few simple “tips” to help improve the connection between you and your horse.

Many may consider the rider’s hands as the “point” that establishes the connection with the horse’s mouth. We often hear a comment like, “that rider has good hands” and we spend a lot of time reading about what we are supposed to do (or not supposed to do) with our hands. As we touched on in part two – often we as riders try to do way too much with our hands. This effects not only where the horse feels most comfortable putting their nose and head but also effects the horse’s whole way of going thru their backs. Hands – what do we do with them? Sometimes we even feel we want to chop them off, but I assure you that will not be necessary!

In actuality you need to make that “point” of connection come not from your hand but from your elbows. When we think of our hands and put too much weight or tension in them, they impede the horse’s movement. Some riders have so much weight in the reins that their whole arm becomes tense which in turn acts like side reins in a restrictive way.

Joanie helps riders to first get that straight line between the horse’s mouth and the rider’s elbow. A lot of riders, out of habit, keep their hands too low which breaks the connection. Once you raise your hands and re-establish that straight line we talked about, the best way to keep the connection is to think of your hands and elbows sliding forward and backwards on a track as if you are sawing a piece of wood.

Joanie uses a lounge line to demonstrate this feel with riders so they get a sense for that elastic connection we strive for. Once a rider maintains the connection thru the rein at the halt (as Joanie mimics the horse’s natural motion of his head along with the stride), they can better

transfer this feel as they ride. As the horse moves his head – focus your attention not on your hands but your elbows as you slide your elbows forward and back to keep the elastic connection at all times.

Often we as riders are not able to maintain that elastic feel of connection thru the reins when we have a habit of letting the reins slip thru our fingers. Sometimes we allow the

reins to slip out of our hands in an attempt to give to the horse, thinking we are doing a good thing. But then we find that our reins are now too long when the horse pops his head up and the connection we thought we had is now lost. The common reaction would be to tighten your whole fist

or fingers to not allow the rein to slip but that only causes undo tension of the hands and arms and does not effect the horse in a positive manor.

The best way to fix this is to remember to slide your elbows forward and back while keeping a steady feel on the reins and not allowing them to slide thru the fingers. A good way to accomplish this is to “tent” your thumbs on the reins to not allow them to slide thru your fingers. This allows a good hold on the rein while maintaining a soft feel in the rider’s arms and thru the reins.

It is amazing how this simple exercise (done first at halt with Joanie, then at the walk, then trot) gets one acutely aware how many times they break the connection by letting the reins go too loose or too tight. As soon as you establish a better connection with the reins, the horse will become steadier and be able to use their neck and back more effectively. Not to mention it makes the horse look a whole lot better! Add the right amount of energy from the horse’s hind end and he will willingly come over his back, soften his neck and reach for the bit. Even horse who once were traveling with stiff necks, backs and upright heads became transformed thru this simple exercise in mere minutes!

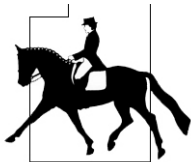

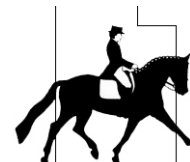
