UDS SHOW AT SOUTH JORDAN EQUESTRIAN CENTER

The 2010 UDS Dressage Show is being held at the **South Jordan Equestrian Park and Equestrian Center** which is located at 2100 West 10800 South, South Jordan, Utah. This is a **CHANGE** from the published Omnibus. The dates are the same, June 25 and 26. This is a Friday/Saturday show.

Our show rings will be indoor this year, a new setting for the annual UDS Dressage show. We will have a table near the show office on the main floor where riders and visitors can purchase UDS items, obtain general information, order additional shavings for the stalls, obtain show programs and the daily schedules, and visit!

The outside warm up arena will be on the north west side of the indoor arena. Lunging will be available west of the warm up arena.

Entry into the indoor arena will occur at the north doors. Only riders and their horses will be allowed inside the door on the show/lower level. All may view rides on the mail floor and you can enter the main floor from the east and west side of the indoor arena. So, you can wish good luck to your rider and horse, enter the viewing area through a door right next to the east door the rider and horse will use to enter the indoor rings, and view the ride from above in the stands.

Heather Blitz Clinic

Heather Blitz is coming June 12, 13!!



ViVenzio Dressage is bringing in Heather Blitz for a two day clinic! Call Marlo Vivenzio for details 801-918-9715, Auditors are welcome – the fee is @20 per day or \$30 for the weekend! The location is yet to be decided and will be announced at a later date (check the UDS website for the location later this month).

Heather Blitz is an international Grand Prix rider who has been based in Europe for the past few years. She is also a popular and successful clinician with her 'Mind Your Riding' Tour which focuses on the effect of the rider's body and aids on the horse at all levels and teaches a clear and easy to understand system of training to riders of all levels. Heather's tours are held in Europe and throughout the U.S.

Heather competed the Danish Warmblood stallion Rambo DVE 373 at CDI level Grand Prix from the competitive circuit in south Florida to the prestigious Dressage at Devon where we were placed as high as 3rd. The scores she earned riding Rambo earned them a place on the USEF Long List an invitation to the USEF team training sessions.

The second horse that has made a huge impact in her career is Arabella, a daughter of Rambo DVE 373. Heather trained her from her first day under saddle all the way to the Grand Prix, getting as far as reserve for the World Equestrian Games 2006. Arabella was a winner in regional championships at age 4 and 5. At 6 years old, she won the FEI 6-year-old Young Horse Championship. At 8 years old they qualified for and competed in the USEF Intermediare championships in San Juan Capistrano, CA and finished in 5th place. They started in Grand Prix together when Arabella was 8 years old and by 10 had qualified for the USEF Grand Prix Championships at Gladstone where they came in fifth overall and were consequently invited to accompany the U.S. team to Germany training together leading up to the WEG in Aachen.

Heather's next Grand Prix horse was Otto – who was also by Rambo. Heather trained and competed him from age 8 to 13 competing throughout Europe and Scandinavia including 3rd place in the Grand Prix Special at the Mondorf CDIO, Luxembourg against Germany's top riders and even beating Isabell Werth.

Heather is now competing with her gelding Paragon at PSG and I1 and scoring high 70s.

Heather has been a guest judge and test rider at the Pavo Cup in Holland (National Championship for 4 and 5 year old horses) and for the Danish National Championships for 5 year olds.

Please note a change away from our usual show date in August:

2010 UDS Annual Show: Friday, June 25th and Saturday, June 26th.

The date was moved to June 2010 so that the UDS could provide qualifying classes for it's riders. Leaving the UDS Annual Show in August, as is customary, would have not allowed 30 days before the Region 5 Championships (September 2-5, 2010), which is required for a class to qualify for the Regional Championships. This change is for 2010 only; in 2011 we will return to our usual show dates in August although we will be moving one week earlier.
