**FEES:** Intro \$35 per test, Training - Fourth \$40 per test; FEI & Freestyle \$45 per test.  
Office fee per entry \$25. Late or change fee \$25; Trailer-in (per horse) fee \$10;  
GAIG/USDF Qualifying fee \$10; USEF drug fee (per horse) \$15; Returned checks \$50;  
USEF non-member fee \$30; USDF non-member fee \$25; Make checks payable to The  
Collectives. Mail entry to Pre-Show Manager, Heather Petersen. Please include a SASE.  
**SHOW COMMITTEE:** The show committee reserves the right to cancel or split classes;  
limit class size; change arenas; limit the number of rides & number of horses per rider; and  
cancel or add judges. The show committee also reserves the right to refuse any entries for  
cause. Every horse entered will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but  
the Horse Show Management is not to be held responsible for any loss or damage that  
may occur.

**ENTRIES:** Accepted on first come, first served basis, based on (readable) postmark. Post  
entries (postmarked after closing date) will be accepted on a space available basis with  
late fee. Once the competition is filled a wait list will be established. Wait list will be  
maintained through July 3, 2011. Current 2011 entry form must be used. Proof of  
memberships and horse registrations must be included with entry. Current negative  
Coggins and health certificate required for all out-of-state horses. IF RIDING FREESTYLE  
INCLUDE A COPY OF QUALIFYING TEST AT 60% OR BETTER. If entry is incomplete,  
horse/rider combo will be placed on the wait list until required paperwork is received.

**TIMES:** Provisional times will be mailed in your SASE. Official times will be posted at the

show office by noon the day before the show. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COMPETITOR TO CHECK OFFICIAL RIDE TIMES DAILY. Numbers required at all times when horse is outside of stall. Adequate time intervals cannot be guaranteed when riders enter more than one horse in any class. All ownership cards must be available for inspection and included with entry.

**REFUNDS:** Up to closing date, all fees refunded except office fee. After closing date no refunds will be provided for any reason. Qualifying fees and drug fee (if horse is not on show grounds) refunded. During competition day, no refunds for any reason including acts of God. Office fees are non-refundable. Wait list riders' fees will be fully refunded if they do not make it into the competition.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons up to third place. One, first place prize per entire class.

**ARENAS:** Sand footed show ring provided outdoors. Sand footed warm-up inside. Only horses with entries will be permitted in the arenas.

**STABLING:** None provided.

**OPPORTUNITY CLASSES:** Opportunity classes are for those wishing to participate in a recognized show experience but who do not wish to participate in USEF/USDF award programs. Participants and horses do not need USDF/USDF memberships and do not pay nonmember fees. At these shows horse/rider combinations may cross-enter into recognized classes with appropriate USDF/USEF memberships or non-member fees.

**MANAGEMENT RULES AND PROCEDURES.** Rings open for schooling by noon August 4th. Protective headgear is required while mounted at all times. Please leave your dogs at home. Sharps containers located in show office and barn.

**DIRECTIONS:** From Main Street in Heber take HWY 40 east towards Vernal. Just before the Weigh Station/Port of Entry Station and across the highway from Suburban Propane is a left hand turn onto a small, unmarked street. Take that left. (If you pass the Port of Entry you have gone to far.) Go up the little hill and when you come to the T in the road, go right and go straight ahead. If there is someone in the ring, do not proceed until the test is complete. There will be signs to guide you where to park which is very limited.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.
