Entrees must be complete which includes complete form and for Championship rides, please include a copy of your USDF membership card, which is automatic with your UDS membership (referred to as your GMO membership with the USDF), and all fees. No hand delivery of entries, must be postmarked and received no later than August 23rd. On show days, riders who scratch must notify the show secretary no later than 30 minutes before the scheduled time. Make checks payable to Utah Dressage Society. Times and Updates: Provisional ride times will be posted on the web at www.utahdressagesociety.org or email the show secretary at Nance@xmission.com after August 25. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm ride times on the day of the show.

Dress: Usual show dress as in rated show. Riders will be notified if/when coats are optional due to weather/temperature. Following USDF rule (DR.120.7) if coats become optional competitors must wear a regulation hat and solid or nearly solid colored long or short sleeved shirt with collar, without neckwear, and without decoration. T-shirts are not allowed.

Awards: Championship rides will be awarded ribbons for Champion and Reserve Champion (1st and 2nd) and will be awarded to the top two scores REGARDLESS OF DIVISION. Open show-Ribbons first through third place by division. In the event of a tie, the total of the collective marks will determine the placing. If a tie remains, show management will break the tie with a coin toss.

Arena: Show ring (outdoor)-20X60 meters, with washed sand and black rubber footing. Warm up arena (indoor)-20X40 dirt/sand footing. Lunging ring (outdoor) 85 ft. round pen with dirt/sand footing.

Stabling: Limited day stalls are available at Sweetwater for \$25 per stall. Please contact Nance Allen at 801-274.1288 to reserve.

Helmet Policy: All riders must wear helmets when mounted per UDS policy.

Food: Bottled water provided by the UDS. Food otherwise on your own.
