These are two separate shows and you must fill out an entry form for each show. Please specify Open (O), Adult Amateur (AA), and Jr. Young Rider (Jr/YR) on entry form. If not specified, you will be placed in the Open (O) division. (Q) indicates a qualifying class for Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Championships for 2010. Amateurs must include a copy of their current USEF card to verify Amateur status with entry. USEF allows 3 rides per day per horse. FEI allows 2 rides per day per horse.

* Pony test of choice classes at the FEI level and Jr/YR FEI Freestyle tests cannot be ridden as RC qualifying tests

FEES:

\$40 per class.

\$10 Great American Insurance Group/USDF qualifying class fee.

\$30 per entry/per day office fee (non-refundable).

\$15 USEF Drug and Medication fee.

\$10 grounds/facility fee per day per horse.

\$10 late/change fee per horse.

\$5 UDS non-member fee (waived for out of state competitors with proof of membership in their state's association).

\$20 USDF non-member fee.

\$30 USEF non-member fee.

\$25 returned check charge.

ENTRIES: Complete entries will be accepted first come-first served, based on postmark or online payment date. Entries are considered complete when a correct entry form, copies of membership cards and all fees are received. No hand delivery of entries. Post entries will only be accepted if time slots are available and not after 7:30 a.m. the day of the show. The show may be closed at 60 riders per day/per judge. Requests for class changes must be e-mailed to the show secretary. On show days, riders who scratch must notify the show secretary no later than 30 minutes before the scheduled time - failure to do so will be considered a "no-show" and subsequent rides may be forfeited. On competition days, empty ride times will be filled from a waiting list. Out-of-state competitors must provide a current negative Coggins and health certificate. Freestyle entries must include a copy of the qualifying test. Numbers will not be given to competitors until their entry is complete. Make checks to: Utah Dressage Society. SPECIAL CLASSES: Second Level Test 3 offers a Dover Medal (DM) prize to the highest score of 58% or above. Materiale F/M is for 3, 4 and 5 year old fillies and mares. Materiale G/S is for 3, 4 and 5 year old geldings and stallions (see USEF DR133 and DR204.2e). Opportunity Training Level Test 1 and Opportunity Training Level Test 2 are classes made available for entry level riders who are experimenting with dressage showing (see USEF GR821). Riders entering Opportunity classes may not cross enter into the rated/recognized classes but they may enter the Intro A and/or B class which are not rated/recognized.

PONY MEASURING: If a pony is not in possession of a fully and correctly completed Measurement Certificate, the pony must be measured by the show TD and the show veterinarian. The pony owner is responsible for all veterinarian fees associated with the pony measurement. Please contact the show manager to arrange for an appointment for measurement. (USEF DR134)

REFUNDS: NO REFUNDS after the closing date or on competition days. \$30 Office fee is non-refundable. Drug, qualifying fees and facility fees will be refunded. If wait listed entries cannot be accepted because of a full show, all fees will be refunded. Refunds will NOT be given for class cancellation due to severe weather, accident or other emergency.

TIMES & UPDATES: Provisional ride times will be posted on the web at www.utahdressagesociety.org or e-mail the show secretary at

vanpatterkay@aol.com after June 22nd. It is the competitor's responsibility to confirm ride times on the day of the show. The show committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes, to change arenas, to refuse any entry and to limit the number of rides per rider to facilitate scheduling.

AWARDS: Ribbons first place through eighth place. Prizes to high percentage: Amateur, Open and Jr/YR of each level each day. In the event of a tie, the total of the collective marks will determine the placing. If the tie remains and prizes are given, show management will break the tie with a coin toss for the prize. Prize money, if offered, will be awarded at the show or within 30 days of the competition.

STABLING: \$20 per night. Provide your own feed. Light shavings in stalls upon arrival. Large bags of shavings available onsite for \$10/bag. You must submit a completed stabling form with your entry to reserve a stall(s). Contact Alison Child for stabling questions 435-640-3287.

SHOW/WARM-UP ARENAS: Two 20X60 meter indoor arenas with dirt/sand footing. Indoor show arenas will be parallel and close together, 10 feet apart with 4 feet of space along the outside rail. Warm up just prior to bell ring or whistle blow will be allowed inside the ring. Main warm up arena is outside with dirt/sand footing. Hand walking around the show arenas during the competition will only be permitted before and after the show. **Lunging** will be allowed in a designated area - not in the warm up arena. Only horses with entries will be permitted in any of the arenas. Numbers are required at all times when the horse is in or around the arenas. Schooling available the evening before the show, Thursday, 6 pm to 10 pm as well as Friday night after the last ride of the day, and until 10 pm.

SAFETY COORDINATOR: On grounds during competition

FOOD: Concessions will be available on grounds.

MISC: NO DOGS PLEASE!

MEDICAL: Medical personnel on grounds during competition.

VETERINARIAN AND FARRIER: On-call. Phone numbers available in the show office. Sharps containers in the show office and in the barn.

CAMPING: Camping allowed in self contained vehicles only. There are no power or water hook ups. Potable water available but must be transported from faucet to vehicle.

DIRECTIONS: From the north or from downtown Salt Lake, take I-15 to the 10600 South exit, exit 293. At exit, turn RIGHT, or west onto 10600 South. Drive 2.2 miles toward the city of South Jordan and turn LEFT onto Redwood Rd. Drive 1.3 miles to 11400 South and turn RIGHT onto 11400 South. Drive 0.4 miles and the Equestrian Park will be on your right. Turn into the driveway which will take you to the trailer and horse unloading area. From the south, take I-15 to the 12300 South exit, exit number 291. Turn LEFT, driving towards Riverton, and at 2.6 miles, turn RIGHT onto Redwood Rd. Drive 1.5 miles and turn LEFT onto 11400 South. Drive 0.4 miles further to the Equestrian Center on your right.
